



2026 Outdoor Season Community Partner/Musician Guidelines & Application

501©3 nonprofits, musicians and those that provide educational demonstration are invited to set up at the market as Community Partners .

Location, Dates & Hours

1. The Outdoor Season of the Canton Farmers' Market will be held on **4th Street NW**, alongside the 4th Street Shops, in between Cleveland Ave & McKinley Ave.
It will be open every **Saturday, June 6th - October 3rd, from 10am-1pm**.
Due to the Hall of Fame Parade, the August 1st market will be open with delayed hours from 12-3pm.
For GPS: 340 4th St NW, Canton, OH 44702.
2. Participants may begin to set up, starting at 8:30am. *NOTE: Market staff will not be onsite prior.*
 3. All set up must be complete prior to the market start time.
4. All participants must stay until the market closes. Early breakdowns and departures are prohibited.
5. **Open RAIN or SHINE, but not in inclement weather. The market will not be cancelled in advance due to unfavorable forecasts (unless a Tornado Warning). However, should inclement weather occur in 44702 during market hours, it will close early out of respect for everyone's safety.**

General Guidelines

1. **Standard free spots accommodate a 10x10 tent. Flexible sized and electric access spots may be available upon request.**
2. **Community Partners are responsible for being self-sustainable and providing their own tents, 25lb+ weights in all 4 corners, tables, chairs & displays. Musicians are provided with a 10x10 tent, table, stool, generator and \$50 cash stipend, with merchandise sales permitted.**
3. The Market Managers reserve the right to place participants in different locations, from week to week, to provide the best possible market diversity.
 4. Participants must display a sign identifying their organization/musician name.
5. **Musicians are welcome to park at their spot. All others are invited to park across the street in the Choices High School parking lot, after unloading.**
6. **Two (2) no call/no shows** will cause suspension from participating in the market.
7. **If unable to arrive by 9:45am, please do not plan to participate on that date.**
8. No loud music, shouting at shoppers, pets, firearms or smoking on premises. ***Musicians, please keep content family friendly and volume at a level where vendors can easily converse with shoppers.***
9. Participants must wear proper attire and keep their area clean and free of debris during the market and promptly remove all personal items and dispose of all trash at the conclusion of each market.
10. Participants are encouraged to assist in promoting the Canton Farmers' Market. The market can be found on Facebook **@CantonOhioFarmersMarket** and Instagram **#CantonOhioFarmersMarket**
11. Know Your Roots has the discretion to deny any application, should it be determined to violate the "spirit of the market." The spirit of the market includes, but is not limited to, a spirit that fosters community and inclusivity, and showcases vendors and their products primarily. Divisive, discriminatory, hateful, or non-inclusive ideology and/or information shall automatically be deemed in violation.
12. No participants shall be involved in political or religious campaigning of any kind and the distribution of information that is political or religious related shall be prohibited at the Canton Farmers' Market.
13. Participants will respect the integrity of the market, its customers and each other.
